

ROUND 1 INTERVIEW

ADAM SVENSSON (-10)

Q. Adam, great round highlighted by a couple of eagles. Just kind of assess the whole round for us.

ADAM SVENSSON: Yeah, I was on the range today and I was feeling really good. I've been putting well, putting a lot of work in that. It just kind of all came together today. I made two nice eagles. The one on 8 was exceptional, made a 30-footer, but was just trying to stay in there because it was just so hot. I was losing energy, I was trying to hydrate and stuff like that. I was just really relaxed and just tried to get through the day essentially.

Q. Take me real quick through the eagles. Just give me some clubs on 8 and 17 if you would.

ADAM SVENSSON: 6-iron and 3-wood. No. 8 was 3-wood and the other hole was 6-iron.

Q. And did you feel a round like this coming on? How have you been feeling kind of ramping up towards this week?

ADAM SVENSSON: Yeah, I've been playing well. I had a couple top-25s the last few events. I've always had not issues but just kind of struggled a little bit with the putter. I've been working more on putting than I have ball-striking. Usually it's the other way around for me, so just I think the extra work and the extra time spent into putting has helped my game even more than just hitting balls.

Q. Was there anything about the greens today and this weather that kind of surprised you to kind of give you this or was it kind of the shooting gallery you expected?

ADAM SVENSSON: I knew there was going to be a lot of low scores. The greens were soft and they roll pretty good. There's a lot of divots and stuff like that, you can bang them in, take some break out and stuff like that. I just go out there and try to do my best. I don't really have a score set, I just try and play the best golf I can.

Q. When you have a round like that, how superstitious are you, if at all?

ADAM SVENSSON: I'm not really superstitious, I just try and play one shot at a time and wherever it goes, I just hit it again.
