

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

MARK HUBBARD (-12)

Q. Mark, another good round today, long one, 67, in really good position heading into the weekend. Just some thoughts about today.

MARK HUBBARD: Yeah, it was good. It was a long day like you said. Woke up at 5:00 and got done at 6:00, so quite the morning round, but I feel like I hung in there well. Didn't hit it as well today as I did yesterday, but managed my game really well and putted good again. I feel like I left a few out after the restart. Greens were a little slower, which I couldn't -- I didn't do a good job adjusting to so I left a lot of putts short. But all in all, a really good day.

Q. At the risk of asking a dumb question, I imagine the course played a lot longer after you went back out?

MARK HUBBARD: It did, yeah, especially for me. I hit it lower than most guys, so when it's soft like this and not running out, definitely plays longer. But it's still, it's one of our shorter courses we play so it was still manageable. We could still get home on the par 5s and it wasn't that big a deal.

Q. How have you been feeling about your game coming into the week, or how's the confidence level?

MARK HUBBARD: Yeah, it's as high as it's been. I think if anything, like I said, because I haven't been hitting it as good as I know I can, the irons have been pretty good but driver's been a little shaky at times and I'm just really managing my game well. And I'm putting it great. When I'm rolling it well, it just frees up everything else, so I'm really confident. There's a lot of work to be done. The score's going to be super low. In my mind I thought 6 today, 24 would be a pretty good number for the week with as soft as it is, so right on pace for that and we'll see what happens.
