

**ROUND 2 INTERVIEW**  
**July 8, 2022**



**ADAM SVENSSON (-15)**

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**Q. Adam, obviously a long day, but you got the job done in 5-under 67. Just a few thoughts on today?**

**ADAM SVENSSON:** Yeah, it was a good day. I just tried to get through the day without having one more suspension there, but I hit it well again today. A couple loose shots here and there and a couple bogeys, but overall it was -- 5 under par was a great day.

**Q. After a day like yesterday that you had, is it a little bit more frustrating to come back today and have the waiting and the starting and the stopping and so forth, or do you just kind of stick to your plan what works?**

**ADAM SVENSSON:** Yeah, it's obviously a little bit annoying because you kind of get out of the routine and stuff like that, but yeah, you kind of do the same thing, same game plan. Obviously I knew that shooting 10 under yesterday, I'm not going to do that again today, so I just tried to get it around in something close to that.

**Q. And last two questions: First of all, how much did the course change from yesterday? Obviously it played a lot longer, I would imagine.**

**ADAM SVENSSON:** Yeah, it played longer. A couple of the par 5s, a lot longer clubs in. Just the greens were still rolling nice, but they were just wet so you had to hit a lot of soft shots into the green and a lot of chippy iron shots or wedges.

**Q. Like Billy Ray asked you outside, how did you kill all the time?**

**ADAM SVENSSON:** Took an hour nap in the car with my girlfriend, hit about 10 bails and went out there.

**Q. Is it pretty easy for you to fall asleep in a car in situations like that?**

**ADAM SVENSSON:** With a 4:00 a.m. wake-up like we had, yeah, it was pretty easy.
