

ROUND 2 INTERVIEW

RICARDO GOUVEIA (-15)

Q. Ricardo, after what must have felt like the longest round of golf, just how pleased are you with a 7-under 56?

RICARDO GOUVEIA: Yeah, obviously very pleased. Played again very solid and yeah, yesterday finished well and today kept it going, which was really nice.

Q. How disappointing was it to have to finish after getting a birdie on the first, your 10th hole?

RICARDO GOUVEIA: It was fine. I knew I was going to play nine, 10 holes when I got out yesterday, so mentally I was prepared for that and yeah, it was -- luckily I came back and made a few more birdies.

Q. Obviously a great finish to your round with two birdies and the eagle as well at the fifth. Can you just talk us through that?

RICARDO GOUVEIA: Yeah, I hit a good drive down the right, perfect second shot. I was in between clubs but luckily decided to go with a 4 instead of a 5 and rolled a nice putt in.

Q. How key is it to keep the momentum going into the third round considering it will be a few hours before you tee off again?

RICARDO GOUVEIA: Yeah, I'll rest a little bit, maybe go back, shower, change and get out there and try to do the same.
